This Clarification modifies and becomes a part of the Contract Documents. Bidder must acknowledge receipt of this Clarification on the Bid Package. Failure to do so may disqualify bidder.

Clarifications:

- 1. Existing window in Classroom 127 shall receive new WC1, as indicated on Al101.
- 2. All Bid Packages shall be received by Pryor Public Schools in the Education Service Center at 405 SW 1st St., Pryor, OK 74361 until 2:00PM, Thursday, March 09, 2023.
- 3. Asbestos Abatement occurs at the exterior and interior of Lincoln Elementary. Mechanical piping insulation referenced in the report has already been abated.
- Asbestos Abatement work duration may be increased to a maximum of 7 week days plus 2 weekend days on the construction schedule, if approved by the Owner and LCS.
- Asbestos Abatement shall occur at all locations where ACM extends under millwork. Asbestos Abatement contractor shall demo millwork as required to properly abate all Asbestos Containing Material.
- 6. If, as a result of unexcused delays in Contractor's performance and completion of the work, LCS shall incur additional expenses and/or become liable to the Owner because of failure to complete the project within the specified time, then Contractor shall indemnify and hold harmless LCS against all such liability and/or additional expense.
- 7. All floor mounted plumbing fixtures shall be removed by the Plumbing Contractor prior to commencement of Asbestos Abatement in restrooms/toilets indicated on the Demolition Plans.
- 8. While Contractor is onsite and performing, and/or scheduled to be performing their work, Contractor shall provide, at a minimum, 16 manhours per week of dedicated project cleanup. This includes, but is not limited to cleanup of all debris created by the scope of their work, the scope of others, and as directed by LCS.
- Existing flooring not shown to demo shall be protected in place by the successful Flooring Contractor. All flooring protection is included in the Bid Package 9.2 -Flooring.
